FAM Referees Development Officer Maxwell Mtonga was delighted with the news saying the experience that Malawian referees get at such international tournaments helps in improving their performance in local competitions.



Mighty Wanderers plan to sell bus

Mighty Wanderers Football Club is planning to sell the bus which former President Arthur Peter Mutharika donated to the team. Team's Chairperson Symon Sikwese has confirmed the development saying that discussions are underway because selling the bus is the best option for the team to meet this season's requirements. Sikwese said: "The decision is being debated, we're discussing because one of the best options we have if we're to finish this season is to sell the bus and use some of the resources to settle players' upkeep, fulfill training and game bonuses for our players."

The Confederation of African Football (CAF) has confirmed the dates for Flames' last two 2022 AFCON qualifying matches against South Sudan and Uganda in March. The Flames will face South Sudan away on Wednesday March 24, 2021 before winding up their Group B campaign at home against Uganda on Monday March 29, 2021. The venue for the away match is not confirmed yet as South Sudan are playing their home matches outside their country.
