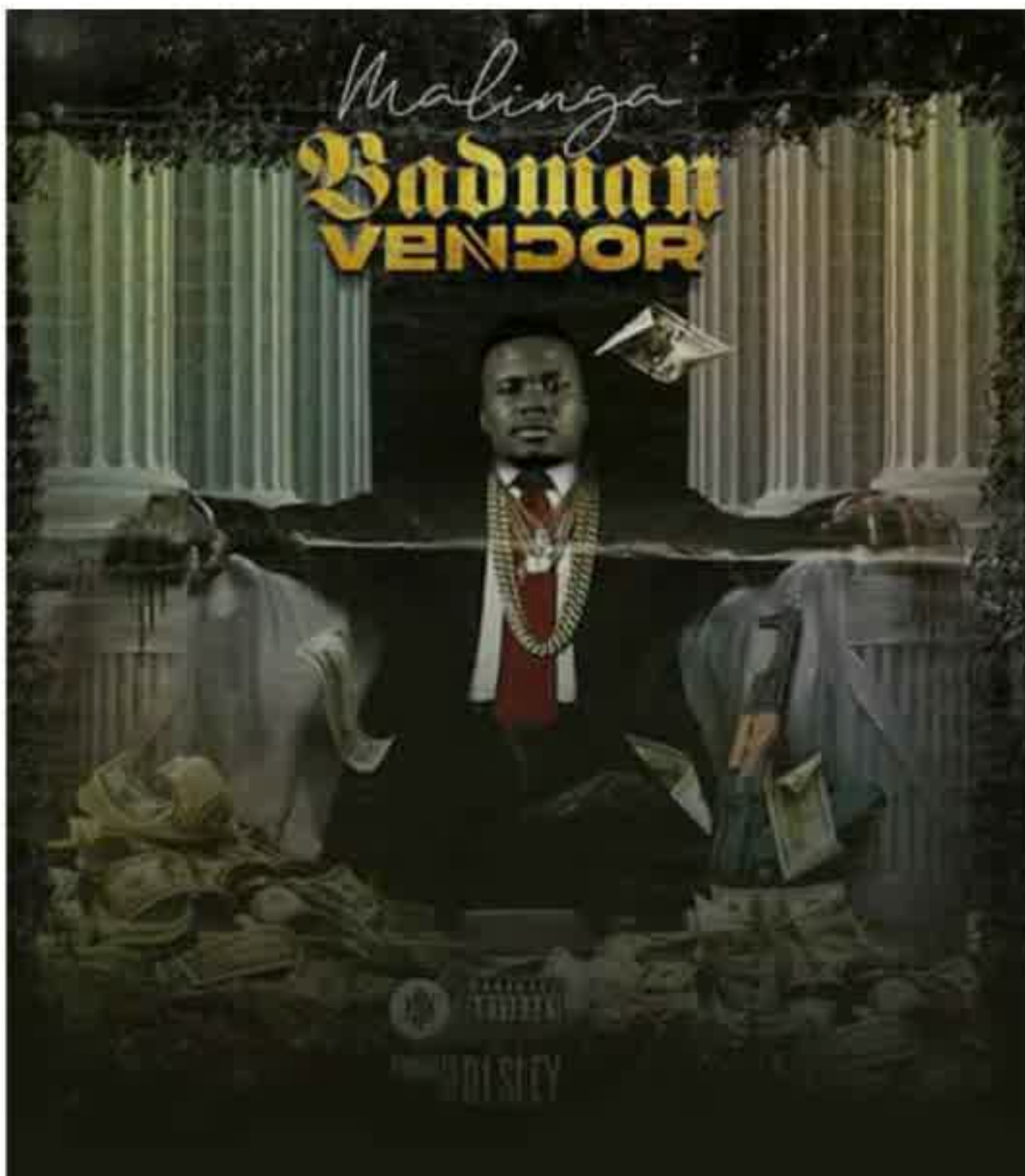
# Malinga drops “Badman Vendor”

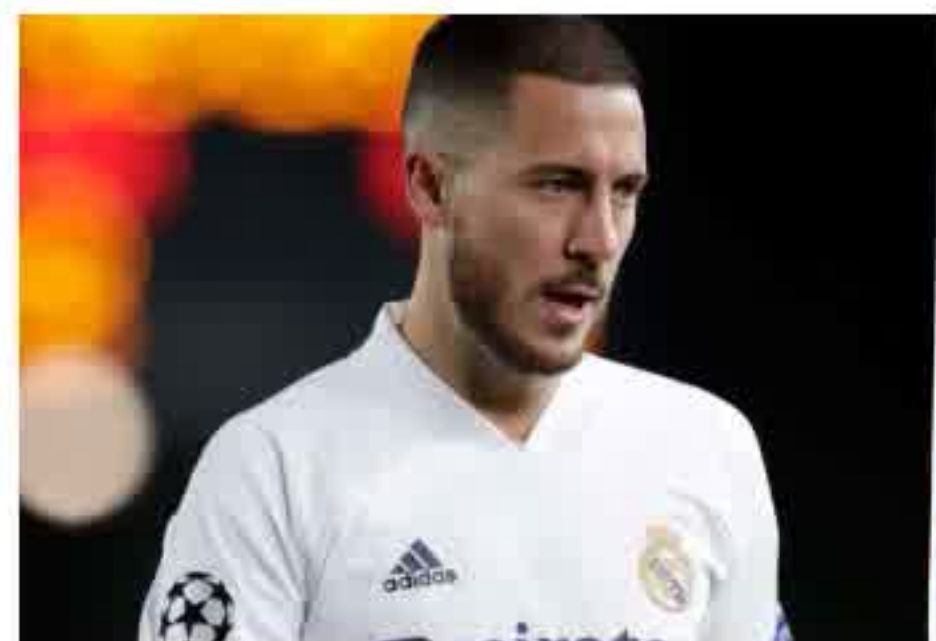
### 'I WASN'T BLOWING THE WORLD AWAY AT HIS AGE' - LAMPARD HIGHLIGHTS MOUNT

The midfielder made the difference for the Blues on Saturday and his manager was delighted with his overall performance. Mason Mount was "outstanding" against Fulham, says Chelsea manager Frank Lampard, who believes the midfielder is better than he was at the same age. The 22-year-old scored the decisive goal at Craven Cottage as the Blues picked up a 1-0 win, their first Premier League victory since December 21. It was the England international's second league goal of the season and Lampard sees him as an example of the precocious talent Chelsea have at their disposal.



### 'HAZARD DOES NOT DESERVE TO BE A STARTER': HOW THE €100M SUPERSTAR LOST HIS WAY AT REAL MADRID

Pressure is mounting on the injury-plagued playmaker with his performances coming in for close scrutiny as the Spanish champions struggle for form. Loic Remy was bemused by Eden Hazard during their first training session together at Chelsea. "He didn't defend well in the session," the French forward told Goal. "He gave away the ball and, at the end of training, I asked: 'You train like this?' "He was like: 'Don't worry, I am the boss.' But not in an arrogant way, as he can be casual when he speaks.



### 'THIAGO DOESN'T PLAY THE LIVERPOOL WAY' - HAMANN ADVISES KLOPP TO BE 'VERY CAUTIOUS' WITH £20M MIDFIELDER

A former Anfield favourite is worried that the Spain international "will change the dynamics" of a title-winning team the more he plays. Thiago Alcantara doesn't play the Liverpool way, according to Dietmar Hamann, who has advised Jurgen Klopp to be "very cautious" with the £20 million (\$27m) midfielder. Liverpool snapped up Thiago on a four-year contract from Bayern Munich in September, in a deal which was seen as a major coup for the newly-crowned Premier League champions. The two-time Champions League winner played a key role in Bayern's run to the treble last season, but chose to take up a new challenge at Anfield instead of signing an extension at Allianz Arena.



### 'HE IS SO GOOD' - XHAKA HAILS PARTEY AFTER HIS STARRING ROLE ON ARSENAL RETURN

The Ghana international made an impressive return to action as the Gunners beat Newcastle 3-0 on Monday night. Granit Xhaka has hailed Thomas Partey's influence on the Arsenal team after the Ghana international impressed on his return against Newcastle United. Partey made his first start in over a month on Monday night and produced an excellent performance as Mikel Arteta's side cruised to a 3-0 win. The 27-year-old set up the opening goal of the night with a wonderful assist for Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang and had completed 55 of his 58 passes before he was replaced by Mohamed Elneny midway through the second half.





## LOCAL NEWS

### MALAWI SUPER LEAGUE SUSPENDED AS CORONAVIRUS CONTINUES TO TROUBLE FOOTBALL

The 2020/21 TNM Super League season has been suspended until February at the earliest due to the new gazzeted rules which have restricted any public gathering to just 50 people. On Sunday, State President Lazarus Chakwera ordered the Health Ministry to Gazette new Covid-19 preventative rules, which among other things, restricted any public gathering to just 50 people from the initial 100 people which was announced by the Presidential Taskforce on Covid-19 committee a fortnight ago. The development has forced Super League of Malawi (Sulom) to suspend the league for three weeks in order to observe the newly gazzeted laws announced by the Taskforce on Monday.

The statement reads: “Super League of Malawi (Sulom) would like to announce that the TNM Super League will go on a three-week recess in order to observe the newly gazzeted Covid-19 prevention laws announced by Presidential Task Force on Covid-19.”



### MIGHTY WANDERERS' WINLESS RUN CONTINUES

The ‘how to win a football game’ formula continues to be out of reach for Mighty Wanderers after they were held to a goalless draw by fellow strugglers Mighty Tigers in the 2020/21 TNM Super League on Sunday afternoon at Kamuzu Stadium. The Blantyre based giants have gotten off to arguably their worst start to a league campaign in history as they have won only one of their seven league games this season. Head coach Bob Mpinganjira made the big call to drop goalkeeper William Thole, Felix Zulu and Babatunde Adepochu by handing Richard Chipuwa and Francis Mkonda their first starts to the season whilst Mike Tete partnered Vincent Nyangulu upfront. It was a game of few chances as both teams struggled to find their feet in the opening minutes of the match.



### CHITIPA TASTE FIRST LEAGUE WIN

Chitipa United on Sunday tasted their first Super League win of the season after beating Moyale Barracks 3-2 at Karonga Stadium. Mathews Sibale gave Chitipa the lead 10 minutes before the end of the first half. In the second half, Moyale came in with a different play and in 61st minute Chrispin fukizi levelled the scores. In the 78th minute, Muhammad Biyasoni came in with another beauty to make it 2 – 1 to Chitipa before Chipala junior added the third goal. In the dying minutes, Moyale scored their second goal through Hassan Upindi. The game ended 3-2 in favour of Chitipa United.
